Guidelines:

- according to current County Codes, all parts of the fence (wall, posts, caps, ornamentals) must not exceed 7' above the finished grade level of the Lot on each side of the fence.
- DCCR 10(a)(xxii) "All fences... shall be designed so as to be attractive from all viewable sides with a height limit of six (6) feet as measured from finished grade level."
- must be 1" inside the property line, or on the property line if your neighbor is sharing the cost
- cement of post holes can extend underground 2.5" beyond property line
- double fencing is not allowed between lots
- acceptable materials are painted wood, composite plastic, vinyl, wrought iron, green-vinyl-covered chain link (back yard only)
- bare chain link is not acceptable nor is chicken wire or any other type of wire fencing material
- all structural supports & hardware must be on the inside so that it is attractive from all exterior viewable angles. The preferred fence is a "good neighbor" fence which looks the same from both sides.
- the fence must be maintained in good repair at all times
- be careful not to build on the 3.5 foot wide "County Strip" which extends across the front of the lots inside the sidewalk except at the end of the cul de sacs where the County Strip is already cemented
